Message from Julie

Tēnā koutou katoa,

A warm welcome back to Term 2. I have been so impressed with how smooth the transition has been from Alert Level 4 to Alert Level 3 with the Bubble Classrooms, to Alert Level 2 and our 'new normal'. On Monday we had approximately 90% of children return to school. The children were amazing and very excited to see their friends and teachers. Everyone has slipped seamlessly back into the routines of school.

A huge thank you to all our parents for your support of distance learning during lockdown. Thank you for supporting us through Alert Level 2, especially with drop-off and pick-up this week. I know it must feel strange not coming into school but I can assure you the children have settled really well into the learning. Just a reminder not to park and leave your car in the drop off areas on Atkinson Road especially at pick up as it stops the flow.

I would like to say a very special welcome to all the new Y1 children who started school during the lockdown. I would also like to introduce Katie Allen, who is the new teacher in Room 24, which opened on Monday with 7 new entrant students. She has done a wonderful job of facilitating 'online visits'.

The teacher-only day scheduled for 29th May has been cancelled, as it didn't feel appropriate to disrupt the learning at the moment.

Usually, in Term 2 we would send out mid-year reports. I feel under the current circumstances a 3-way conference between teacher, parent and child would be more appropriate so you can receive more detailed information about your child's current achievement levels, next steps and how you can help at home. We have two days scheduled in the calendar for 1st and 2nd July. There will be more details available as the term progresses.

Our Titirangi School App has a new feature!

The COVID-19 Check-in module will enable us to keep a contact list of all visitors entering our school during Covid-19 Alert Levels.

Parents/Caregivers & Visitors can use the App to:

- 1) Check into the school on arrival by registering your details
- 2) Show staff confirmation screen if requested
- 3) Check out when leaving the school grounds.



Download the FREE App via the Google Play Store for Android, the App Store for iOS, or scan the QR Code.

As this is an updated release of the App, this may mean you will need to reinstall the App to ensure you are running the App version 2.4.0 or greater.

Please note - If your child is late to school or leaving school early for an appointment you will still need to come to the office to sign your child out. Please do not go to their classroom first.


