Tēnā koutou katoa,

Term 2 Reporting

Usually, at the end of term 2 parents receive a mid-year report detailing their child's progress. After discussions with the teaching staff, we feel it is more appropriate under the current circumstances to offer an alternative reporting method for our families.

We would like to invite parents and students to attend a conference with their teacher to discuss where they are currently at with their learning and their next learning steps. The teachers will have prepared a document that indicates current achievement levels in reading, writing and maths, which will be shared and discussed with both you and your child. There will also be suggestions on how you can help at home.

The conference is a 15 minute time slot and bookings will go live **Monday 8 June at 9:00 am** and close on **Friday 19 June at 3:00 pm**.

I know there will be some disappointed students, choir-trainers, parents and teachers. The APPA would like to thank you for your understanding and support and we look forward to celebrating the 80th APPA Music Festival in 2021.

Contact Tracing

The Ministry of Health has created a NZ COVID Tracer QR code poster for our school which is is now available to use. You will see the posters displayed around the school, as well as our NZSchoolsApp, which you can use to Check in/Check out. You can also sign in at the office if your phone does not work. We don't mind which option you use but do ask that you ensure you register using one of these methods if you enter the school gates.

Drop off / Pick up

We have found, (as have all other schools in New Zealand), that over the past three weeks, our children have developed great self-management skills and independence through our drop-off and pick-up procedures.

BENEFITS WE HAVE OBSERVED:

- --->Student independence is high
- --->Student organisation and self-management have improved
- --->There is virtually no separation anxiety
- --->Relationships with teachers and students have strengthened
- --->Less traffic congestion around the gates, especially at drop-off
- --->Less/no noise outside the classrooms during learning time, particularly at the end of the day when it can be very distracting

In preparation for the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday, if the decision is to move towards Alert Level 1, entry to the school grounds will remain at 8.15am onwards for students. I encourage parents as much as possible to continue with the 'kiss good-bye at the gate'. I would also like to be clear that you are more than welcome to visit the classroom to celebrate your child's learning before or after school.

At pick-up time parents will be able to wait in the court area under the shades rather than in the car park. If you have arranged an alternative pick-up point please continue as this has proved to be very helpful in terms of the congestion around the school.

I will send a confirmation email once the prime minister's announcement has been made.

I do want to say a huge thank you to our school community. All of our students have returned to school this week. You have shown fantastic support for all the guidelines we have put in place over the different Alert Levels.
